



MA in Professional Development for Language Education

Mode: Full or part-time through modular delivery. You can do the full MA (180 credits) or use fewer credits (60/120) to gain a postgraduate certificate or diploma qualification.

Length of Study: 1 – 5 years (as appropriate)

Attendance: Taught modules in Norwich are of 2 or 3 weeks duration

Entry Requirements: You should have a degree (or equivalent) in a relevant discipline, plus language teaching experience and the level of English needed for successful completion of a course of study at postgraduate level. You may also be considered if you have extensive language teaching experience but few or no formal qualifications.
