



Jigsaw Activity Exchange

Focus: Getting teachers to focus on what they do successfully in the classroom

Materials needed: activities and accompanying materials brought by teachers to an INSET ses-

Aims

- To give teachers a chance to share and learn from each other's practice

Procedure



1. At least one day in advance, ask teachers to bring to your INSET session an activity they have successfully used with their learners and any materials they need to teach or show their colleagues how to do the activity in class.
 2. During the INSET session itself, give teachers a grid similar to the one below in which they can make notes on the activities they experience. Explain that their notes will be useful when they share the activities with others later on in the session.
 3. Divide teachers into groups and ask them to share their activities. Monitor and support if need be, and make notes on points of interest.
 4. Jigsaw the groups so that each new group contains at least one member from each of the previous groups.
 5. Ask teachers to share the activities from their previous groups, including their own activity, in the new group. Monitor and make notes as in step 3.
- Take plenary feedback on points of interest which arose during the activity exchange, and add any relevant summarising comments of your own.
