



Shouting Dictation

Focus: Listening & Speaking

Level: A2 upwards

Key Language: Personal Information



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Aims

- To develop listening & speaking skills
- To practise specific phrases and vocabulary
- To develop higher order thinking skills

Shouting Dictation

Procedure

1. Divide the students into As and Bs.
 2. Give all the As 4 sentences about you, 3 which are true and 1 which is false.
 3. Give all the Bs 4 different sentences about you, 3 which are true and 1 which is false.
 4. Have all the As sitting in a row, facing the Bs.
 5. When students are ready, get them to dictate the sentences to each other, across the room.
 6. When each pair has finished dictating the sentences to each other, they can get together and check their sentences.
 7. Each pair then decides which 6 sentences are true and which 2 are false. They need to give reasons for their answers.
 8. Conduct class feedback and reveal the correct answers.
- **Tip 1:** With a large class you can have the pairs dictating to each other back-to-back, rather than across the room.
 - **Tip 2:** With a small or quiet group, you can play some music while they are dictating the sentences to each other to encourage the students to speak up.
